Electrical Engineering Connections

The Electrical Engineering Connections is an Ontario-wide bridge to work program designed to support internationally-trained electrical engineering professionals with their integration into the Canadian labour market. This interactive **online** program will help you gain knowledge of the Canadian and Ontario electrical codes and standards, labour market prospects, job search strategies and professional licensing in Ontario. There is an opportunity to receive job search support in-person if you are located near the program office.

PROGRAM COMPONENTS

Sector-specific modules: Overview of Health and Safety Codes and Standards; Applications of Measuring Instruments and Ontario Electric Code; Overview of Industrial Automation in Ontario Energy Systems and Electrical Equipment in Ontario (by Humber College); other sector specific workshops including industry projects and Professional Engineering Ontario (PEO) licensing.

One-on-one coaching: One on one career coaching from an Employment Consultant who is knowledgeable about the sector; referrals to job openings and connections to employers in your sector.

Job search modules: resume writing and customization; labour market information; interview preparation; social media and networking; Canadian workplace orientation; creative problem solving assessment and workshops; business communication and job retention supports.

Professional networking: webinars, mentoring, panel discussions, virtual recruitment events.
