### Program Details and Eligibility

- ✓ Approximately 6-8 weeks processing period following application submission to the Ministry
- ✓ Have a relative need/priority for skills training
- ✓ Have been laid-off and unemployed OR be from a low-income household and experiencing challenges attaching to the labour market
- ✓ Be a resident of Ontario
- ✓ Be a Canadian citizen, or permanent resident, or meet the 900-series Social Insurance Number (SIN) policy
