### **Program Eligibility**

- Women who are citizens, refugee claimants, landed immigrants, and convention refugees
- Receive Ontario Works, a social assistance program administered by Toronto Employment Social Services. Clients must be working with a Toronto Ontario Works caseworker and be residents of Toronto\*.
- Legally able to work in Canada (having applied for a work permit is sufficient)
- ✓ Interested in pursuing a career in the customer service industry

\*Includes Etobicoke, Scarborough, North York, and central Toronto. If clients are working with an OW caseworker within the catchment area of Toronto Employment Social Services (TESS), they are eligible for the program.
