Between 2019 and 2023, the Canadian life sciences industry attracted \$25.9 billion in investments across more than 175 companies, reflecting strong investor confidence in the sector's value. Ontario aims to expand the biomanufacturing workforce from 72,000 to 85,000 high-value jobs by 2030, as part of its Life Sciences Strategy.

- ✓ Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) Level 7
- ✓ Minimum of 2 years of professional experience in the biomanufacturing sector outside of Canada
- ✓ Have not been away from the life sciences field for a period longer than two years
- ✓ Strong interest in pursuing a career in Ontario's biomanufacturing sector
