- Plan to arrive in Canada within the next 2-6 months
- Post-secondary education completed with a minimum of two years of experience in your field of employment
- Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) level 7/8 or higher
- Are committed to actively participating in virtual services, including self-directed e-learning, conducting labour market research, and engaging in job search activities before arriving in Canada
