Participants learn a range of sector-specific job seeking strategies, explore non-licensed career pathways and build the skillsets necessary to transfer their healthcare experience into non-licensed roles in the broader healthcare sector. Participants are regularly connected with employers interested in hiring internationally educated healthcare professionals.

Healthcare Connections has two streams:



Health Systems: Put your healthcare skills to use in healthcare administration, pharmaceuticals, clinical research and other fields.



Community Health: Build healthy communities by pursuing employment in community health centres, public health, non-profit health organizations and other employers.

- ✓ Health Systems Stream:
 - Permanent Resident or Convention Refugee
- ✓ Community Health Stream:
 - Permanent Resident, Convention Refugee, Refugee Claimant with a one-year Canadian work permit, Naturalized Canadian Citizen, or Ukrainian Nationals with CUAET Visa
- ✓ Completion of post-secondary education outside of Canada
 - Primarily designed for IEHPs in fields of medicine, pharmacy, dentistry or allied health professionals
- ✓ Minimum 1 year of related work experience in healthcare from outside of Canada
- ✓ Little to no relevant work experience in the extended Canadian healthcare sector
- ✓ Must reside in Ontario
